

## Two CIRANO Fellows honored by McGill University and the Canadian Economics Association

**Montréal, may 30, 2013** – Claude Montmarquette, CEO of CIRANO and professor emeritus at the University of Montreal and Marcel Boyer CIRANO Fellow and Professor Emeritus at the University of Montreal receive the recognition of their peers.

• McGill University is one of the oldest universities in Canada and among the best universities in the world awarded a *Doctor of Laws, honoris causa* Claude Montmarquette.



A global leader and innovator in the fields of experimental economics and applied econometrics, Professor Montmarquette's research focus is the application of experimental economics to questions of economic policy as it relates to education and health. The author or editor of eight books and over 70 scientific articles, the results of his work have had significant impacts on the development of public policy both at home and abroad. He is an elected fellow of the Royal Society of Canada and professor emeritus of Economics and holder of the Bell-Caisse de dépôt et placement du Québec chair in Experimental Economics at the Université de Montréal. He was named a member of the Order of

Canada in 2012 and voted a Great Montrealer in 2010.

The title of Fellow of the CEA is conferred to recognize the achievements and contribution to the discipline of the most prominent economists who have spent a significant portion of their career in Canada.



Marcel Boyer (Ph.D., Carnegie-Mellon University) is Emeritus Professor of Economics, Université de Montréal, where he was Bell Canada Professor of Industrial Economics and Jarislowsky-SSHRC-NSERC Professor of Technology and International Competition (École Polytechnique). An elected member of the Royal Society of Canada and recipient of numerous academic prizes, he is an Associate Member of the Toulouse School of Economics and was President of the Canadian Economics Association, President of the Société Canadienne de Science Économique, CEO of CIRANO, Member of the Board of Directors of the National Bureau of Economic Research, Member of the National Statistics Council of Canada, Member of the Board of Directors of the Social Science and Humanities Research Council of Canada, and Chairman of the Board of the Network for Computing and Mathematical Modelling. Author or co-author of over 260 scientific

articles and papers and public and private reports, Marcel Boyer co-edited in 1984 (with Richard E. Kihlstrom) Bayesian Models in Economic Theory, (North Holland), co-edited in 2006 (with David Martimort and Yolande Hiriart) Frontiers in the Economics of Environmental Regulation and Liability (Ashgate Pub), and in 2009 (with Michael Trebilcock and David Vaver) Intellectual Property and Competition Law (Irwin). He published in 2006 (with Michael Moreaux and Michael Truchon) Partage des coûts et tarification des infrastructures and in 2009 Manifesto for a Competitive Social Democracy. He rejoins the six Fellows of the CEA inducted to this day: E. Diewert, A. Scott, R. Lipsey, D. Laidler, M. Parkin et J. Helliwell.
