► Marcel Boyer – D.J. Trump's Infrastructure Plan: What is it? How innovative is it? What it could be?

The proposed Infrastructure Plan of D.J. Trump promises to "Pursue investments in transportation, clean water, a modern and reliable electricity grid, telecommunications, security infrastructure, and other pressing domestic infrastructure needs ... [and] Create thousands of new jobs ... to build the transportation, water, telecommunications and energy infrastructure needed to enable new economic development in the U.S., all of which will generate new tax revenues." But the program is attacked by many economists: Paul Krugman (NY Times), R.A. Klain (The Washington Post), Larry H. Summers (Harvard), etc. Marcel Boyer will provide a fresh look at The Plan and give answers to the above three questions.

Launch of the Baromètre CIRANO 2016

CIRANO, January 26, 2017, from 12 pm to 2 pm

Whether we talk about the state of transportation infrastructure, oil exploration, retirement income, air pollution, transportation of hazardous materials, access to health services, the Canada-Europe Free Trade Agreement, the use of GMOs or the sharing of data produced by Internet-connected objects, there are many areas of concern. Come and see the results of the CIRANO 2017 Barometer, which will portray Quebeckers' concerns and perceptions of 44 social issues. Comparative analyses over the last five years will also be presented since the Barometer is the result of surveys administered by Léger since 2011 with a sample of 1000 respondents representative of the Quebec population.

For its sixth edition, Le Québec économique discusses in detail the various facets of the infrastructure challenge in the context of a low-growth economy in Québec.
