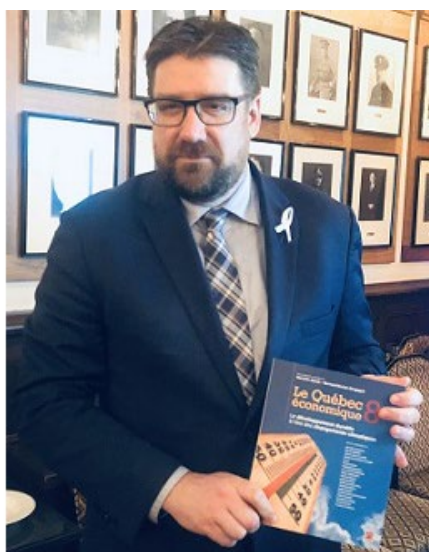

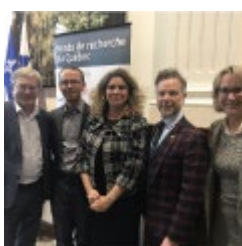
Several CIRANO Researchers participated in the American Economic Association Annual Meeting
