Using advanced **data science** techniques, the Carrefour will offer a new perspective on understanding the economic impacts of fragile supply chains in the St. Lawrence-Great Lakes corridor. The vision, methodology, concepts and team involved in implementing the **digital twin** are outlined on the new website **GVCdtLab**, which hosts our data platform called **SLGL dataHub**.
